WARM UP: Specific times and lanes will be assigned after all of the entries have been received. We will assign lanes and times based on the number of swimmers and the distance each team has to travel to the meet.

All ISI safety procedures will be followed during warm-up sessions. We will try to assign lanes to teams so you may run Warm-ups with only your team in your lane(s). The starting block covers will remain on the blocks until the lanes have been declared one way sprint lanes. Once the covers have been removed the lanes will be one way sprint lanes.

ENTRY LIMITATIONS: Swimmers may enter four (4) individual events and both relays. Swimmers may swim up in relays according to the Illinois Area Swimming rules.

AGE: The swimmer's age is as if December 1, 2016. Please include each swimmer's age on the entry forms.

RULES: NCAA and Illinois YMCA Swimming rules will govern the meet.
