Entries should be submitted in Hy-Tek format via email, immediately followed by the hard copy, fees and waiver via

standard mail. No late entries will be accepted.

FACILITY: New Berlin Eisenhower has an 8-lane, 25-yard indoor pool with 6" non-turbulent Anti-Wave Line Dividers and

backstroke flags. Pool depth ranges from 8' at the starting end to 4' at the turn end. Starting blocks are Spectrum Single Post Xcellerator with rails and foot-boards; block height is 28 3/4" from the water surface. Depth of pool at the turn end requires 2nd and 4th leg of 100 yard relays to begin in the water. Timing system is OmniSport 2000 with backup plunger and two manual backup watches per lane. The competition course has not been certified in accord with USA Swimming

Rule 1042.2(c).

Spectator seating in the pool is first-come-first-serve.

SCHEDULE: <u>Saturday</u>

Morning Warm-upMeet Starts7:30-8:30 AM8:40 AM

Saturday will include 2 sessions, with Session 2 featuring Senior distance events. There will be a 10-minute warm-up for Session 2 immediately after the conclusion of Session 1.

<u>Morning Warm-up</u> <u>Meet Starts</u> 7:30-8:30 AM 8:40 AM

An estimated meet timeline will be posted on our website at www.nbswim.org by Wednesday evening, February 12, 2020.

WARM-UPS:

Warm-up lanes will be assigned by the Meet Director. A USA Swimming registered coach must supervise swimmers. Feet-first entry from the starting end of the pool during general warm-ups will be enforced for all sanctioned/approved competition in accordance with Policy 4.5.2(a).

Six lanes will be used for competition, there will be one buffer/not usable and one cool down/warmup lane for the meet. If it becomes necessary by the Meet Director all eight lanes may be utilized based upon number of enteries.

ELIGIBILITY:

Swimmers age is as of February 15, 2020. All teams must hold current 2019-20 USA Swimming memberships. All swimmers must have valid 2019-20 USA Swimming membership cards. Out-of-state swimmers must bring their USS cards with them.

COACHES:

Coaches packets will be available at the timing table on pool deck. Any monies owed <u>must</u> be paid before you can obtain your packet. Please be prepared to show your current USA Swimming Coaches credentials when Coaches packet is picked up.

EVENTS:

All individual entries will be pre-seeded timed finals except for the 1000 Free, 400 IM, and 500 Free, which will be positive check in and deck seeded, fastest to slowest. Events may be combined by gender due to time constraints, at Meet Director discretion. Entries may also be limited if necessary to meet session time limits. **Positive check in will close 30 minutes prior to the start of the session**.

All swimmers 8 and under will be staged. 8 and under 25-yard events will start from the blocks and swim from the deep end to the shallow end.

RELAYS:

Any changes to relay entries must be submitted to the Meet Director 30 minutes prior to the start of each session. Relay teams will swim in their age level groups. Please include ID number, first and last names, age and order of swim on the relay form in the Coaches packet.

All 8 and under 2nd and 4th relay swimmers will start in the water and will NOT dive into the shallow end for their exchange.

ENTRY LIMITS:

Swimmers are limited to four (4) individual events each day, plus relays.

ENTRY FEES:

\$5.00 per individual event, plus \$3.00 per swimmer WI LSC Splash Fee and \$5.00 per swimmer facility fee. \$12.00 fee per relay.

DECK ENTRIES:

Deck entries will be accepted only to fill partially filled heats at the discretion of the Meet Director. No additional heats will be added. Deck entry fees are \$8.00 per individual event and \$16.00 per relay, plus \$3.00 WI LSC Splash Fee and \$5 facility fee if the swimmer is not already entered in the meet. Deck entries must be submitted prior to the officials meeting, 30 minutes prior to the start of each session. No USA Swimming Membership deck registration will be accepted.

DISABLED

SWIMMERS: Coaches, please alert meet management as to any special needs for your swimmers.

RULES:

2019 USA Swimming and Wisconsin LSC rules shall prevail.

Pursuant to Wisconsin Swimming, Inc. mandate, all applicable adults participating or associated with respective meet to which this information applies, acknowledge that they are an applicable adult, subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand the compliance with the MAAPP Policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.

AWARDS:

Individual: 1st to 3rd - Medals, 4th to 16th - Ribbons for 8+U, 9-10 and 11-12 age categories.

1st to 8th - Ribbons for 13-14 and Senior age categories.

Relays: 1st to 3rd – Ribbons

Heat winner awards will be given for all events 12+Under.

All awards (other than heat winner) will be mailed to coaches following the meet.

ADMISSION: \$5.00 per day. Children under 10 admitted for free.

HEAT SHEETS: Heat sheets will be sold at the meet for \$3.00 at the admissions table. Heat sheets will also be available at

www.nbswim.org prior to the meet. An electronic copy will also be provided to each team's coach or representative prior

to the meet for distribution. Coaches will be provided with printed copies of heat sheets at the meet.

CONCESSIONS: A wide variety of hot and cold food items will be available.

MEET RESULTS: All teams will receive final results via email. Results will also be available on the New Berlin Swim Club website at

www.nbswim.org and on the Wisconsin Swimming website.

Meet results should be available on Meet Mobile the day of the meet.

CONDUCT: Each team will be responsible for the conduct of its swimmers and parents. Misconduct will be dealt with by the Meet

Director, Meet Marshal, and Head Official as appropriate. Misconduct may result in disqualification from participation and/or immediate expulsion from the premises. There can be no lounging in the hallway between the pool and the gym. Please observe posted signs. Per USA Swimming rules, only coaches, swimmers and meet personnel are allowed on the pool deck and in the team bleacher area. Spectators must sit in the designated areas. Except where venue facilities require otherwise, changing into or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms or designated areas is prohibited.

Meet Marshals shall have the authority to remove any swimmer(s) from the meet for any violation such as improper behavior, damage to property, etc. Teams will be held responsible financially for any damage to property. Please make sure your team's area on deck is picked up at the end of each session.

Any swimmer entering the meet unaccompanied by a USA Swimming member coach must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. It is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal quardian to ensure compliance with the requirement.

In accordance with the Federal Video Voyeurism Prevention Act of 2004, the use of video recording devices and camera phones in the locker room is strictly prohibited.

DRONES: Unless approved in writing in advance of the competition by the Vice President of Program Operations, operation of a

drone or any other flying apparatus is prohibited over the venue (pool, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas, and locker

rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials, and/or spectators are present.

FIRST AID: Injuries must be reported to the Lifeguard and Meet Director. A first aid kit will be available at the Lifeguard station.

LOST & FOUND: Lost and found will be located at the admissions table.
